- Check all have suitable footwear/clothing and gloves
- Do not work alone - keep with your team
- Use litter stick, not hands, to pick up litter
- Ensure you can see what you are picking up
- Do not touch face, eyes or mouth whilst working
- Wash hands after litter picking
- Keep skin covered - cover any cuts
- Don't take any risks

Look where you are walking and avoid slippery banks. Look after yourself and others, and enjoy the event.
