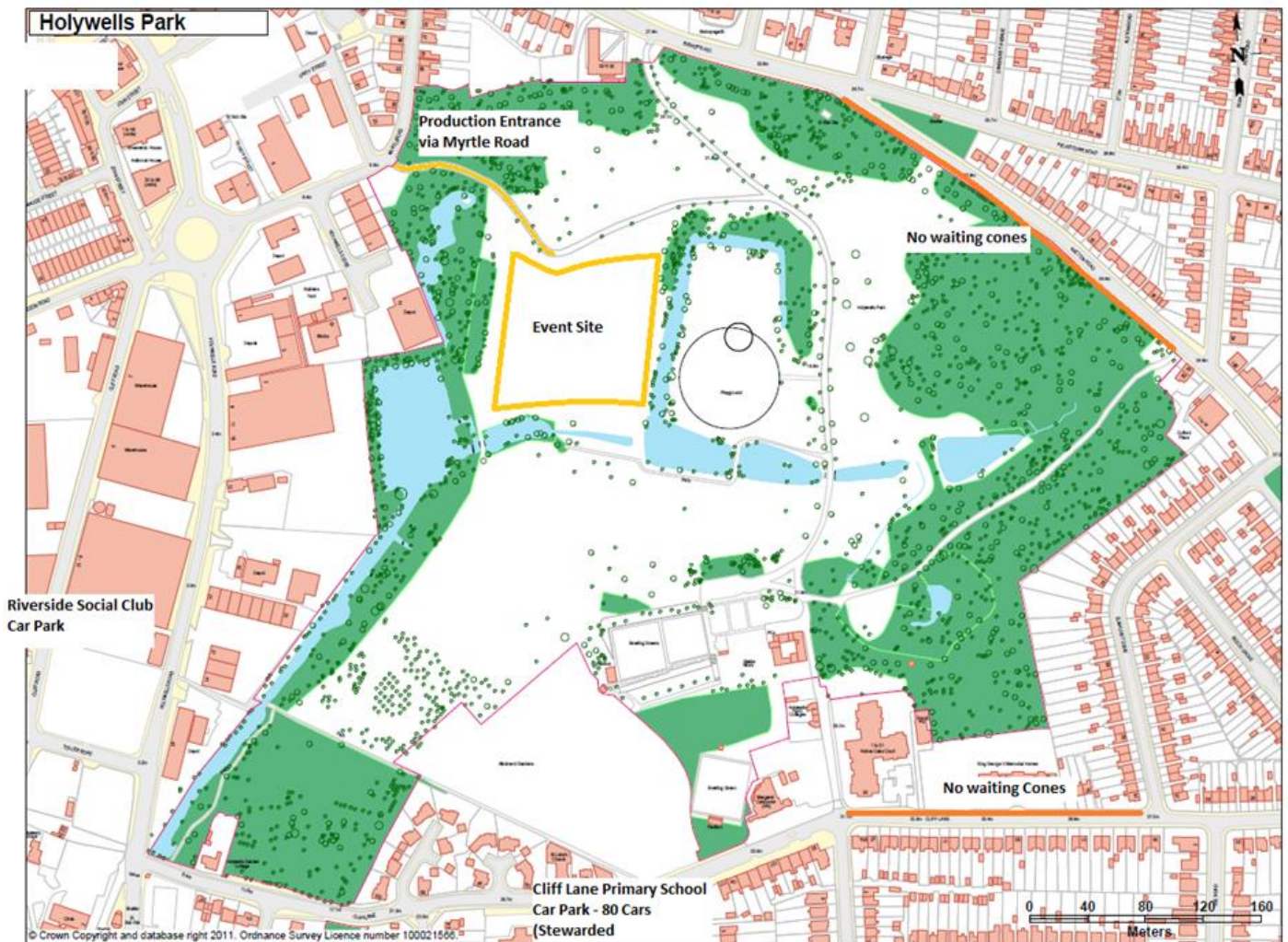


Holywells Park - Traffic Management Plan – Events



Overview

Revision of the Traffic Management Plan for 2016 following issues raised in 2015

All production traffic for all events will be sited either on the park no later than 90 minutes prior opening to the public or given space in off-site parking.

Event times will vary with additional steps taken to reduce disturbance to residents for events finishing past 10pm:

Regular Sound Monitoring / Transport Solutions / Managed Exit Strategy / Considerate Programming

All events will be managed by the Ipswich Borough Council Events Team with assistance from the Holywells Park Team

Access

Production and traders will enter using the Myrtle Road entrance adhering to a strictly monitored 5MPH speed limit

The public may access on foot through all entrances of the park.

Signage

All entrances to the park will be manned and clear directional signage guiding public to the public car parking will be erected

Deployment of Cones

No Waiting' cones will be provided for the duration of the events season and will be deployed on each event day from 6am in the following areas:

Nacton Road / Cliff Lane / Dereham Avenue (Deployment Shown on Map)

There is also scope for cones to be deployed in other roads of interest surrounding the park.

Parking

Three assigned car parks are to be advertised as part of the events:

Cliff Lane Primary School - 80 Spaces, supervised by professional Stewards

Rivers Social Club - 30 Spaces, supervised by Professional Stewards.

Athena Hall Car Park – 94 Spaces, clearly sign posted from Holywells Road

Traffic flow expected

Public arrival at all events is expected within 1 hour of all events starting

Public dispersal 1 hour post event

Public Transport / Limited Parking

All promoters are required to heavily advertise the use of public transport and to convey the message that parking spaces are limited
