Lifeguard

Main Purpose of Job

To work as a member of a team supervising and controlling swimmers and customers at the Swimming Centres ensuring that safety policies are maintained.

Main Duties

To maintain observation of the Pool and its users in order to anticipate and prevent problems and accidents.

To operate and install any equipment required to satisfy the programming requirements of the Pool.

To undertake or assist in water/land based rescues where necessary

To give immediate First Aid, CPR and EAR as required.

Communicate with users and other Lifeguards to fulfil the safe and proper operation of the facilities.

To initiate emergency action plans where necessary.

To undertake cleaning duties in line with the swimming centres cleaning schedules and COSHH regulations

Attend staff training regularly in line with RLSS guidelines to meet minimum requirements to keep NPLQ award valid.

Such variations as may be required from time to time without changing the general character of the duties shown above or the level of responsibility entailed.
