Matter 3 Housing Provision - Gypsy and Traveller Accommodation

Question 50: In the absence of the allocation of any new gypsy and traveller accommodation sites within the ILPR, how and where will the need for additional permanent pitches required from 2021-2026 be met within the Borough during the Plan period, to ensure compliance with paragraph 10 of the PPTS?

This relates to East Suffolk Council representation number 26397.

The Statement of Common Ground agreed between East Suffolk Council and Ipswich Borough Council in June 2020 (Document A25) set out an agreed modification to Policy CS11 Gypsy and Traveller Accommodation in respect of short stay stopping sites. It is noted that further modifications to CS11 and paragraph 8.141, in respect of the provision of permanent pitches, are set out in the live document of main modifications (Document I31) as a result of a Statement of Common Ground between Ipswich Borough Council and Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils (Document I3). East Suffolk Council also supports these further proposed modifications which help to align the policy with the Ipswich Strategic Planning Area Statement of Common Ground (Document A21).

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
