## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 IPSWICH BOROUGH COUNCIL (SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF IPSWICH) (STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2019) PERMIT FEES AMENDMENT ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that Ipswich Borough Council ("the Council") under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, has made the above Order, the effect of which is to amend certain aspects of the Ipswich Borough Council (Suffolk County Council (Borough of Ipswich) (Stopping, Waiting and Loading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019, as amended, by:

- Introducing new charges or varying existing charges or fees that apply for various permits or waivers within the Ipswich Residents Parking Scheme, as shown in the table below (exemptions will apply for holders of a disabled person's blue badge). The times during which the scheme is in operation are as shown on the Map Schedules to the 2019 Order (as amended) but are not changing and will remain as Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm, except for School permits which are only in force for 15 minutes before and 15 minutes after the start and end of the school day, Monday to Friday term times only and Place of Worship permits which are only in force for up to up to 3 hours at specified times on a given day. Classes of vehicle remain as described in the Order (goods vehicle, invalid carriage, motor cycle and passenger vehicles). Unless otherwise stated, permits are valid for 12 months unless revoked in accordance with the Order. The method of issue of permits remains unchanged.
- 2. Varying the fees that apply for parking bay suspensions, dispensations and waivers, and administration refund fees, for all on-street designated parking places within Ipswich, as shown in the table below.
- Making other miscellaneous changes, including clarifying the terms and conditions under which a Place of Worship Permit may be issued.

Zone 3 – Argyle Street, Blanche Street, Bolton Lane, Cemetery Road, Christchurch Street, Clench Close, Cobbold Street, Constable Road, Finchley Road, Hayhill Road, Hervey Street, Jeffries Road, Lacey Street, Lancaster Road, Newton Street, Norfolk Road, Orchard Street, Palmerston Road, Samuel Court, St. Helen's Street, St. Margaret's Green, Suffolk Road, Tuddenham Avenue, Tuddenham Road, Upton Close, Warwick Road, Wells Close, Westerfield Road, Withipoll Street and Woodbridge Road. Zone 4 - Alderman Road, Benezet Street, Bramford Road, Bullwer Road, Burlington Road, Clarkson Street, Crescent Road, Dalton Road, Dillwyn Street, Dillwyn Street West, Emlen Street, Gaye Street, Granville Street, Handford Road, London Road, Norwich Road, Portman Road, Rendlesham Road, Sir Alf Ramsey Way, Stevenson Road and Wilberforce Street.

Zone 5 – Austin Street, Belstead Road, Bulstrode Road, Felaw Street, Great Whip Street, Luther Road, Martin Road, Philip Road, Purplett Street, Selwyn Close, Seymour Road, Stoke Hall Road, Stoke Street and Tyler Street.

except that the fees for suspending a parking bay, providing a dispensation to park in a suspended parking bay and other waiver certificates, and School permits, and Place of Worship permits, and refund administration fees will apply in all on-street designated parking places in Ipswich, including those within Ipswich Residents Parking Zones 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. The Order was made on 19th September 2024 and will come into effect on 1st October 2024. A copy

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made apply for the purpose to the
