Description	Grey gault brick building designed by W Macintosh Brooks in 1836. Formerly the courthouse and County Hall. The frontage is about 150ft long with a central entrance block with twin castellated towers, castellated side wings and 2 slightly projecting end pavilions.
Suggested Use	A flexible approach to uses would be considered compatible with the historic interest of the building.

Condition	Poor
Reason for Risk	Vacant site since 2003/4
Ownership	Private
