

2026/27



Where your Council Tax goes

In 2026/27 people who live in Ipswich will pay 99.86 million in Council Tax.

This money goes to the following:

- Suffolk County Council gets £70.06 million (70.2% of the total).
- Suffolk Police & Crime Commissioner gets £12.32 million (12.3% of the total).
- Ipswich Borough Council gets £17.48 million (17.5% of the total).


These authorities also get money from the Government, from fees and charges and from Business Rates to pay for the services they provide. Business Rates are collected locally, with an element being retained by the authorities and the balance paid over to the Government.

The Borough Council collects the money on behalf of all the authorities.






Where we spend the money
