

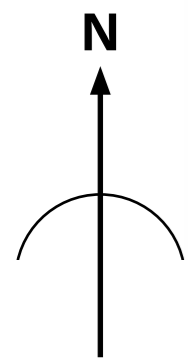
Enjoy an outdoor walk

Holywells Park Walking Routes

The Green Flag Award winning Holywells Park is a beautiful natural space close to Ipswich Waterfront. Well known for its wildlife and facilities, including a large play area and splash play zone, exercise trim trail, formal gardens, café and plenty of green space to play and explore, this park has something for everyone.

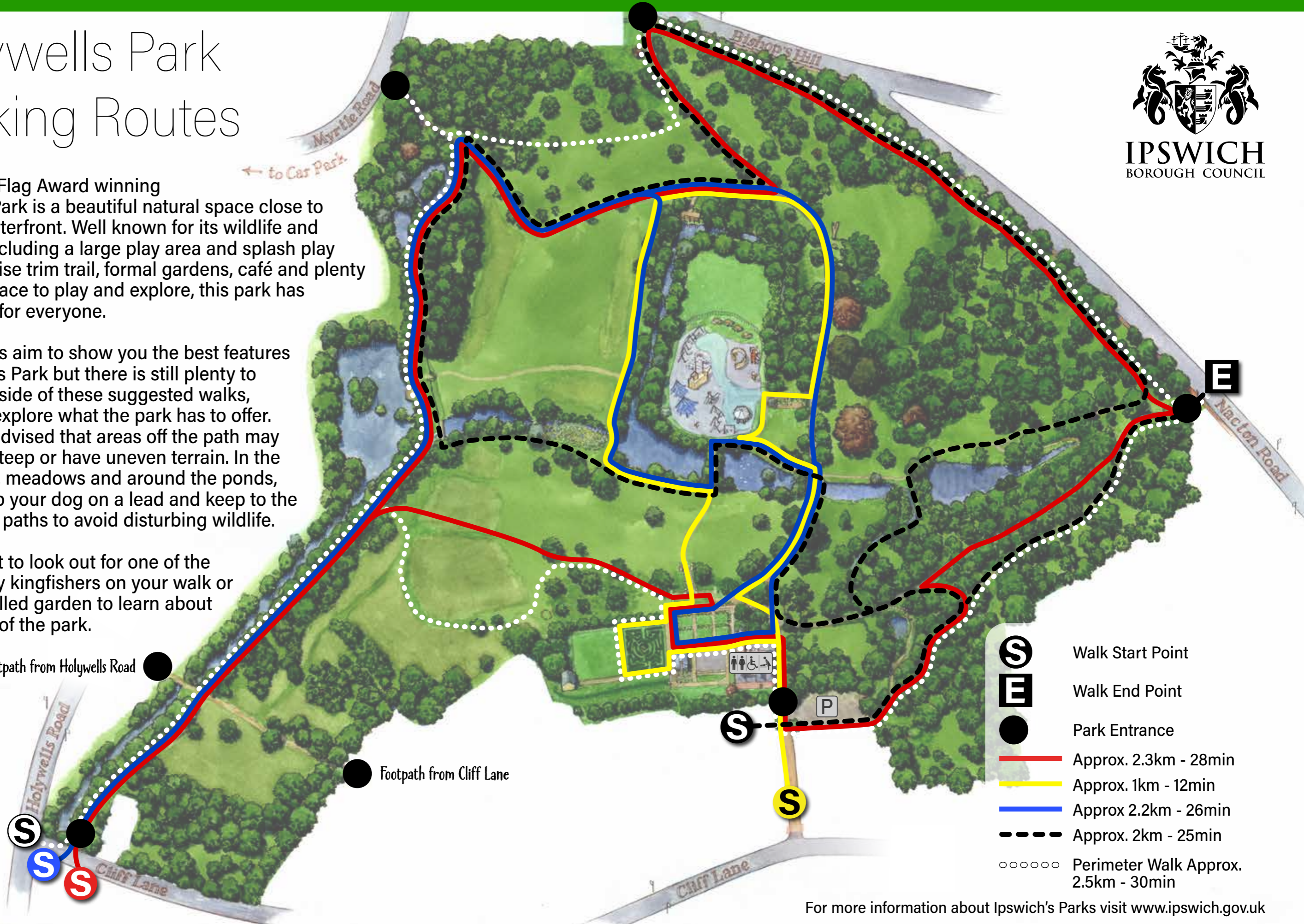
These walks aim to show you the best features of Holywells Park but there is still plenty to explore outside of these suggested walks, so go and explore what the park has to offer. Please be advised that areas off the path may have wet, steep or have uneven terrain. In the woodlands, meadows and around the ponds, please keep your dog on a lead and keep to the designated paths to avoid disturbing wildlife.

Don't forget to look out for one of the park's many kingfishers on your walk or visit the walled garden to learn about the history of the park.
