What is proposed?: To review the tariffs and charging hours for the Council's off-street car parks.

Why are the changes being introduced?: The Council has seen a significant reduction in income from its off-street public car parks and, taking into account the need to encourage the use of sustainable transport modes, is now proposing to increase parking charges and the times at which they apply. However, this is balanced by continuing to ensure that these charges remain competitive compared to those charged by private sector operators in order to try to help the town centre economy.

What evidence is being used to support this Equality Impact Assessment, and how is it being used?: A qualitative assessment of the proposals and their impacts.

How will this change be implemented?: If approved by the Council's Executive Committee a statutory public consultation will be carried out on proposals to make a new legal order (known as an Off-Street Parking Places Order) for the Council's car parks in accordance with the proposals in the committee report.
