The general nature and effect of this Order is to: * revoke the Ipswich Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020 and the Ipswich Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 2022;
- * amend the charging hours at all of the Council's public parking places from 08:00 to 20:00 daily to 08:00 to 22:00 daily (08:00 to 23:30 at Crown parking place)
- * introduce a convenience fee of £0.10 for paying a parking charge electronically by utilising any electronic programme that the Council may make available for the purpose;
- * change the '2 after 2' (£2 after 2pm Monday to Friday) promotional offer to '£2.50 after 2pm' (£2.50 after 2pm Monday to Friday);

* prescribe or vary the charges that apply at parking places within the Borough of Ipswich; and

* make various other miscellaneous provisions.
