

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

IPSWICH BOROUGH COUNCIL (SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF IPSWICH) (STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2019) AMENDMENT ORDER 2022

Ipswich Borough Council ("the Council") under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, proposes to make an Order, the effect of which will be to amend certain aspects of the Suffolk County Council (Borough of Ipswich) (Stopping, Waiting and Loading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019, as amended, by:

- Varying the existing charges and maximum stay for parking at the on-street paid for designated parking places shown in the table below (exemptions will apply for holders of a disabled person's blue badge).
- Varying the charging hours for parking at all of the on-street paid for designated parking places shown in the table below, from 08:00 to 18:00 daily to 08:00 to 20:00 daily, except at the Cromwell Square on-street paid for designated parking place where the charging hours shall be varied from 08:00 to 18:00 daily to 08:00 to 22:00 daily, and except at the Fonnereau Road and Soane Street on-street paid for designated parking places where the charging hours shall be varied from 09:00 to 18:00 daily to 08:00 to 20:00 daily.
- Introducing a 'Convenience Fee' of £0.10 for the use as a method of payment for parking charges at any on-street paid for designated parking place within the Borough of Ipswich (including for clarity all those listed in the table below) any electronic programme as the Council may make available for that purpose.
- Making other miscellaneous changes.

Classes of vehicle remain as described in the Order (disabled persons' vehicles, goods vehicles, invalid carriages, motor cycles and passenger vehicles). The dates on which the changes are proposed to come into effect are also shown in the table below. It is proposed that the current '2 after 2' (£2 after 2pm Monday to Friday) special promotional offer available at the Cromwell Square on-street designated parking place will be changed to '£2.50 after 2' (£2.50 after 2pm Monday to Friday).
