What is proposed?: Ipswich borough council has led on a Housing First project since 2018. The existing support services contracts both end on 31st March 2023 and we need to procure support to cover the period from 01/04/2023-31/03/2025.

Why are the changes being introduced?: There will be no change to the existing project requirements, this form is being completed as part of the procurement process

What evidence is being used to support this Equality Impact Assessment, and how is it being used?: IBC has been leading on this project since 2018. We have collected data around the service users and outcomes since this time.

How will this change be implemented?: Upon completion of the procurement support providers will be engaged to deliver the intensive wrap around support for the Housing First service users. This will be described in the contract specifications. Providers must comply with all duties under the Equalities Act and this will be determined by assessing tenders. The project is open to all assessed rough sleepers who meet the criteria of being entrenched in chaotic lifestyles and willing to engage with the project to make positive changes and establish a home in the community.
