

## Listed Buildings in Ipswich

The following list outlines Ipswich buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest as defined by the Department of Culture Media & Sport.

This is the third version of the list which was first compiled on 04/08/1972 (but including subsequent List amendments up to No:72 [08.11.2012], but excluding subsequent total demolitions).

Buildings of outstanding importance are defined in bold. The introduction of Local Land Property Gazetteer (LLPG) has resulted in some address changes. The old addresses are given in italics in brackets.

This address list is **for reference purposes only**. All buildings are Listed Grade 2 unless otherwise specifically noted in brackets in bold.
