

Inspection Notes – M.G. Kerry Vehicle Resprayers

5th November 2012 – Louise Burns met Mike Meadows

Certificate of compliance seen confirming emission limit provision of booth – under 10mg/m³.

Condition 2,8,9

Thorough maintenance programme in place. CAMCO used to maintain all booth and dust extraction systems. Filters changed every 6 months. CAMCO can be called out next day if necessary.

Condition 3

Hardly any dusty wastes visible, dust extraction used during the rubbing down process.

Condition 5

Daily visual checks undertaken although not recorded. Monthly checks of all equipment including seals, structure etc taken, records kept.

Condition 12

Booths operate under negative pressure-gauge visible on exterior

Condition 19

There is no written procedure for dealing with waste wipes. Mike explained that they are left on the floor to dry and then placed in a skip. Guidance requires that they are placed in a sealed container prior to collection.

Condition 20

There is no spillage equipment available in solvent handling areas, however as so little solvent is used [mostly recycled] the risk of spillage is much reduced.

A Unic G003 Combi Solvent Recycler machine has been installed 6 months ago. There is very little VOC waste now as most of it is recycled.

Company is subject to PAS auditing – all staff drained in procedures.
