

Inspection Notes – Simon Morris Ipswich Ltd

Certificate of compliance seen confirming emission limit provision of booth NOT AVAILABLE

1 large booth which can be split in two. Booths large enough to spray lorries and coaches. Pressure valve visible on both sides of booth.

HVLP spraying equipment used.

Spray guns cleaned in totally enclosed cleaning machine, waste solvent stored in a closed container.

Used solvent wipes are stored in a closed bin prior to collection by Envirocon.

Absorbent granules are available for any type of liquid spillage.

Filter material for the floor of booths is kept on site. Should other spares be required, either Spraybooth or Movac area called to assist and offer a same or next day service.

Maintenance records seen, booths are serviced twice yearly. Top filters are changed twice yearly but bottom filters are changed every month or when necessary. Staff know when to change the bottom filters as the pressure in the booth is incorrect and the door will not close properly.

A new dust extraction system has just been installed throughout the unit - details to follow

Staff are trained using the Movac Safety Net training scheme. Records kept at head office.

Should there be any emissions from monitoring or malfunction, the booth is closed down and Spraybake Technology is called out to repair etc. Usually same or next day service.
