- 1. Provide a guarantee that the booth extraction ensures that particle emissions are under 10mg/Nm3.
- 2. Please provide your annual VOC usage figures and ensure that this is forwarded to the Council annually.
- 3. Undertake a daily check of emissions and keep a log of such checks.
- 4. Provide details of the newly installed dust extraction plant to include dust extraction levels.

Your process has achieved a risk rating of LOW.
