# Inspection Notes 03/12/12 Cement Batching Plant

Inspection carried out by Louise Burns with Nigel Stephenson with reference to the recent guidance PG3/01(12).

Batching plant only used for a couple of hours a day as demand is low. Site in good clean condition.

## **Condition 1**

Visible emissions monitored and recorded daily.

## **Condition 2**

Documents associated with application state that silos are designed to emit less than  $10 \text{mg/m}^3$ .

## Condition 3

New in house maintenance management system [MMS]in place to cover calibration and maintenance.

## **Condition 6**

High level and High High level alarms on all silos, alarm will sound and delivery automatically stops.

## **Condition 8**

Displaced air emits through the pressure relief filters [WAM].

## Condition 10

One conveyor, not currently covered – sand inherently damp so to date not necessary – **will ask Nigel to monitor** 

## **Condition 11**

Waste stored in bay in large lumps, taken away by waste contractor

## **Condition 14**

Spray bars around discharge point

## **Condition 15**

Training records on site and available to view
