Alexandra Park Walking Routes

Alexandra Park is close to Ipswich Town Centre and Ipswich Waterfront. A perfect park for picnic and play, Alexandra Park has history for the parents and loads of play equipment for the kids.

These suggested walks aim to show you some of the best features of Alexandra Park but there is still plenty of park to explore outside of these suggested walks. Please be advised that some paths may become muddy and slippery in adverse weather conditions. In the wildlife areas around the pond and newly planted trees, please keep your dog under control to avoid disturbing wildlife.

Remember to take a look at the Byles Fountain by the Grove Lane Entrance. The fountain is dedicated to the Byles Family who donated the park to the town and created the commemorative fountain in 1905.
