

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995

DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4(1) IN RELATION TO PART OF THE WALK IN THE BOROUGH OF IPSWICH

WHEREAS the Ipswich Borough Council ("the Council") being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(6) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out within a certain area of land which comprises part of The Walk in the Borough of Ipswich and which is shown edged red on the attached plan, unless permission is granted on an application made under Part-III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule below and that this Direction may be cited as the 'Borough of Ipswich (Part of The Walk) Article 4(1) Direction 2004'.

THE SCHEDULE

The carrying out on land within the boundaries of an unadopted street or private way of certain works for the maintenance or improvement of that street or way, namely any works which have the effect of altering the materials used for the surface of such street or way, being development comprised within Class A of Part 9 of Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

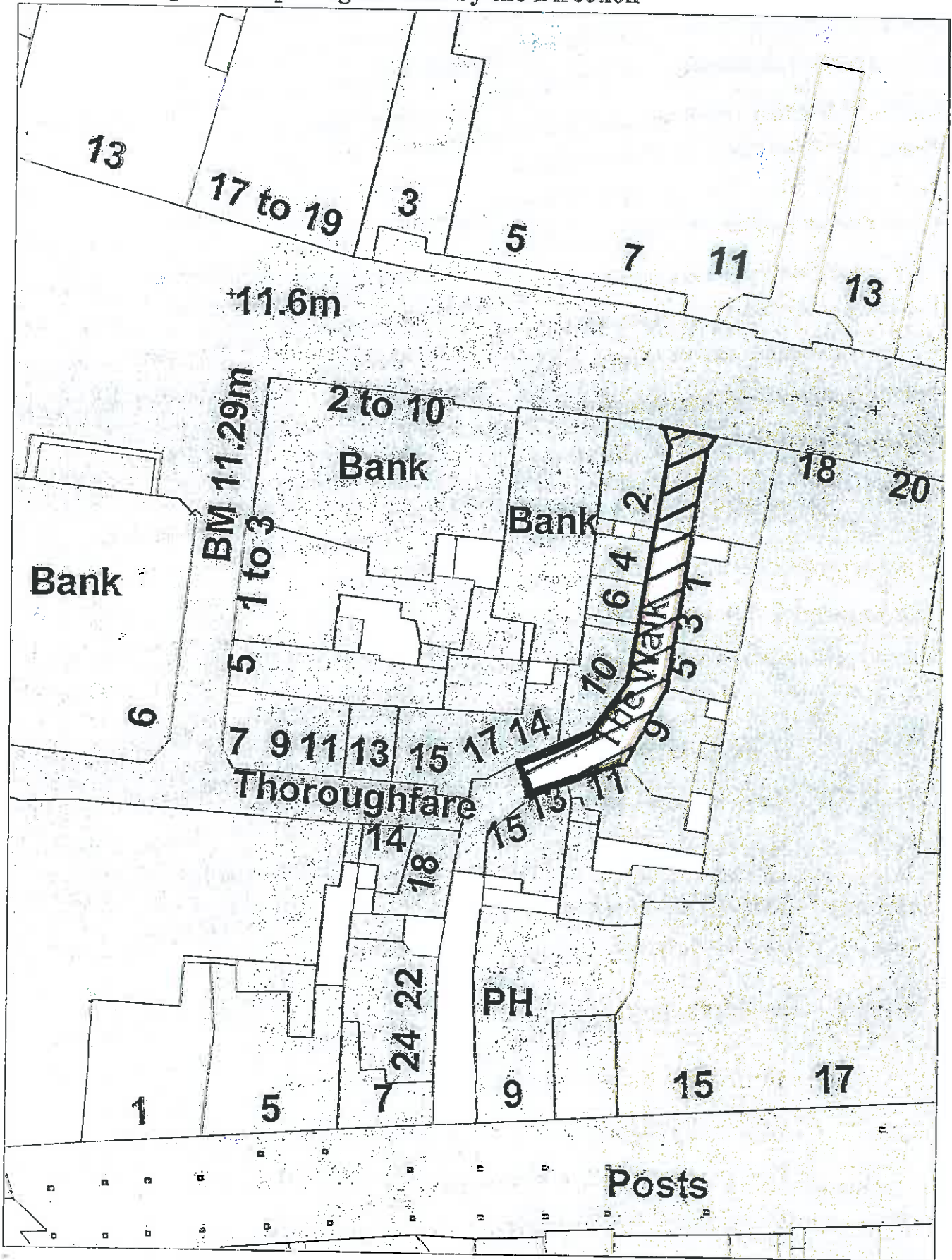
