

# Enjoy an outdoor walk

## Braziers Meadow and Wood Walking Routes

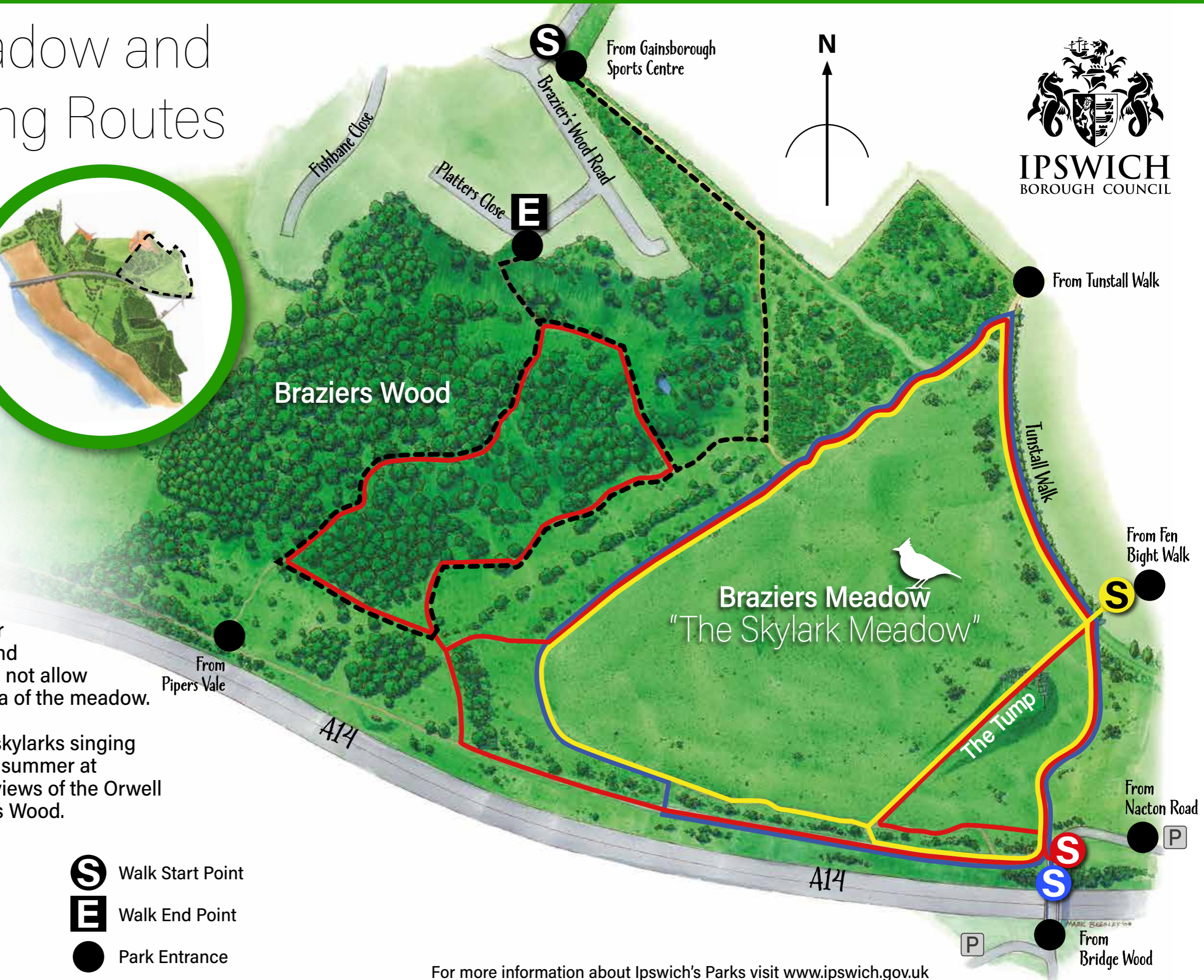
Part of Orwell Country Park, Braziers Meadow and Braziers Wood are fantastic wildlife features of the town. Locally important for protected species, this is the perfect place for a spring dawn chorus walk or a stroll on a warm summers evening.

These footpaths are designed to take you around the meadow with the best views of wildlife but also preventing disturbance to the important breeding bird populations. Please keep to the designated routes and keep your dogs on a lead on the path around the perimeter of the meadow, do not allow your dog to enter the fenced area of the meadow.

Listen to the beautiful sound of skylarks singing from spring right through to late summer at Braziers Meadow or take in the views of the Orwell Bridge and estuary from Braziers Wood.
