The current housing central heating installations contract is coming to an end. A new four year contract has been prepared and tendered to ensure continued replacement of old inefficient systems. The new contract allows for upgrading of boilers to an 'A' rated energy efficiency standard in the Councils housing stock to keep homes to decent homes standard and meet the Councils own Ipswich Standard.
