



Notice of review of polling districts and polling places 2023-2025

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013, Ipswich Borough Council is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places.

The (Acting) Returning Officer for Parliamentary constituencies of Ipswich and the North Ipswich part of Central Suffolk and North Ipswich will make representations on the proposals. Those representations will be published on the council's website from **20 November 2023** or can be inspected at the address below.

We welcome representations from electors within the authority area or within a UK Parliamentary constituency that has any part in the authority area on any aspect regarding the council's proposals for polling districts or polling places.

We also welcome representations from interested persons or groups, particularly those with expertise in disability access issues on the authority's proposals, the (Acting) Returning Officer's representations or any other matters.

Any persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, provide alternative places that may be used as polling places.

Representations can be made in writing to the electoral services team at the address below or by email. All representations that we receive must be published and made available for inspection.

The deadline for making representations is **29 December 2023**.

The final proposed arrangements (following receipt of any further representations) will be considered at the meeting of the Full Council on **24 January 2024**. The outcomes of the review will be published thereafter. Any changes will be implemented on the register of electors republished on 1st February 2024.
