

## **Consultation Statement for the Draft Suffolk Coast RAMS SPD**

In June 2017, the Council published a Call for Ideas on the Draft Suffolk Coast European Sites Recreational Disturbance Avoidance and Mitigation Strategy Supplementary Planning Document (Suffolk Coast RAMS SPD). The consultation was carried out under Regulation 12 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012. The call for ideas was issued through a Local Plan Newsletter available on the Council's web site and posted to everyone on the Local Plan database. A period of six weeks was allowed for comments to be submitted, between 14<sup>th</sup> June and 26<sup>th</sup> July 2017.
