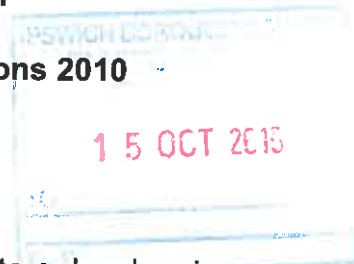

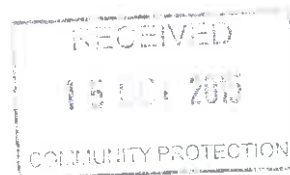

## **B The installation**

A. Dry cleaning solvents kept next to machine in a barrier to prevent spillage spreading.

B. Dry cleaning residue kept in locked shed at back on a flat ground also inside a barrier to prevent spillage going in to drain.

SATRA, based Kettering runs a Solvent Emissions Directive Practical 1 day course for regulators and cleaners.

The loads will be weighed using a Spring scale in Kilograms. It will also be recorded on a weekly and a annually inventory sheet.

It is determined by recording the amount of solvent used during the reporting period to top up the machine solvent storage tanks. Where a mixture of solvents are used (including PER), then the amount of each <sup>individual</sup> ~~required~~ solvent used will be <sub>required</sub>

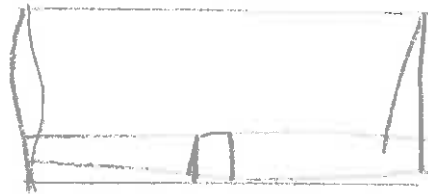
