Holywells Park Holywells Park extends to 67 acres (28 ha.) of picturesque grounds with a history dating back to medieval times. It has a diverse range of habitats supporting native and non-native trees. Most if not all the non-native species were planted during the Cobbold era of the park (1812-1930).

Use the map on this leaflet to help you navigate around the tree trail. There are 24 trees identified on the trail. An interactive phone app will allow you to learn about each tree on the trail as you near it. See back of leaflet about downloading app.
